Extending the Promises Summary

Total Goal: \$2.1 million—half of the previous \$4.2 million infrastructure portion of the \$6.2 million Standing on the Promises effort.

About 15 necessary facility upgrade projects, mostly in the 2001 atrium, classrooms, and Fenn Hall addition.

We will avoid large and long-term debt by proceeding as funds are available with the as-needed option for short-term, conservative borrowing against commitments.
